

Container kitchen herb gardening – Materials list

(Please note these materials are optional. The instructor will demonstrate a container herbal basket in class).

Only students who bring the following materials to class will leave with a completed herbal basket to take home.

Materials:

1. One Basket – flat on bottom, solid sides to hold bark inside. Length enough to accommodate six, 4 inch by 4 inch, live potted herbal plants in their plastic container and deep enough to be placed inside basket without rim of plastic container visible.

Recommended basket size - 12 inches in length, 8 inches in width and 4 inches in depth.

2. Six – 4 inch live potted herbal plants in their plastic container. A greater number of plants will be too heavy to carry out of class. A smaller number of herbal plants is acceptable, but not as interesting.

Instructor will provide basket fill material in class.

Please note: herbal plants in their plastic containers can be raised up to 2 inches to meet the top to the rim of the basket.

Herbs may be purchased at any good retail plant nursery, including Armstrongs, Orchard and Home Depot. Potted herbs should be the same size.

Baskets may also be purchased at any good retailer including Pier One, World Market, Bed Bath & Beyond, Target, Kohl's, Ross (limited selection).

It is recommended, however, that the basket be brought at the plant nursery and six potted herbs be placed inside the basket to ensure the correct size of the basket has been chosen.
